

Speed Control

Rock Anthem Workshop

Overview

Following a 45-minute performance first thing in the morning, the three members of Speed Control will work with your students throughout the day to compose an original rock anthem for your school. At the end of the day, they will teach the assembled student body the new song. Within several weeks after the event, Speed Control will make a studio recording of the anthem that will be sent to the school.

Prior to the day:

Ensure that the gym is booked for the entire day. The drums, amplifiers, etc., will be set up all day so regularly scheduled activities that take place at that time may not be able to go ahead as planned. The group can, of course, clear away their gear and work with students elsewhere so that regularly scheduled events in the gym can take place. However, additional time will need to be worked into the schedule for re-setting in another room, and re-setting once again in the gym for the end of the day.

On the day of the workshop:

Speed Control will arrive an hour early to set up. They will need a change room and access to electrical outlets.

Sample Schedule:

8:00 AM – Speed Control arrives and sets up

9:00 AM – Performance for the entire school in the gym

10:00 AM – Work with students to write the anthem

12:00 PM – Lunch Break

1:00 PM – Continue working with students

2:15 PM - Assembly for entire school where Speed Control will teach the new song to students and staff

3:00 PM End of Day

Follow-up

1. The school must ensure that Speed Control has a contact person at the school who will oversee the follow-up. (This person should be familiar with MP3 files, and various transfer applications such as DropBox, WeTransfer, etc.)
2. The lyrics for the anthem will be sent to the school for approval. The school must approve the lyrics in writing prior to the anthem being recorded.
3. After the anthem has been recorded, an MP3 file will be emailed to the contact person at the school (No hard copy CD will be produced).

Turn-around Time

Speed Control will endeavor to get the recorded anthem to you within eight weeks of having been at your school, possibly sooner. The timing of this is subject to the band's touring schedule and access to a professional quality recording studio.

Confirmation of the Day's Activities
