Who is the Vancouver TheatreSports League?

The VTSL is an award winning improvisational comedy theatre company with over 30 years of history in improvisational comedy, spawning such talent as Ryan Stiles and Colin Mochrie, who starred in the "Whose Line is it Anyway" series.

Who will teach this Improvisational Acting Workshop?

The VTSL Improvisational workshops are taught by experienced veteran members who have many years of experience on-stage and have performed professionally for thousands of people. These same actors have countless hours teaching in classrooms and at THE IMPROV CENTRE, home of the VTSL.

What will the participants learn?

These workshops are specifically designed to introduce students to the concepts and basic principles of improvisation. Students will learn the skills needed to be spontaneous and foster uninhibited creativity. They will learn to accept and value the ideas of others, create a supportive environment to take risks, build confidence and presentation skills. Learn to communicate and express ideas, individually and within a team environment.

How will the students learn these skills?

The VTSL has created a series of exercises and games that will have the students up on their feet from the first moment, exploring these concepts in various sized groups, all the way to the individual level.

How long is the workshop?

Our standard workshop is 2 hours and limited to 24 students per instructor.

What is the cost?

The minimum is \$400 for a two-hour workshop, unless the workshop is booked in conjunction with a performance.
